

INFORMATION CLAUSE

- HTL-STREFA S.A. with its registered office in Ozorków (ul. Adamówek 7, 95-035 Ozorków) is the controller of the personal data that you provided in the contact form. - 2. Your personal data will be processed for the purpose of responding to the inquiry submitted on the contact form. Processing your personal data for any other purpose requires your express and voluntary consent.
- 3. Providing personal data is voluntary but necessary in order to handle your inquiry submitted on the contact form.
- 4. You may withdraw your consent to the processing of your personal data that you provided on the contact form and the withdrawal of consent does not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal. You may revoke your consent by sending a statement to that effect to info@htl-strefa.pl.
- 5. Your personal data will be stored as long as it is necessary to handle the inquiry submitted on the contact form.
- 6. Your personal data will be provided solely to persons or entities authorised by HTL-STREFA S.A. to process data or to entities that HTL-STREFA S.A. entrusted with the processing of personal data (including information and communication service providers), as well as public authorities empowered to receive the data under generally applicable laws.
- 7. Your personal data will not be shared with any third countries (i.e. countries outside the European Economic Area).
- 8. You may access, correct and rectify your personal data and, to the extent stipulated by the law, to delete, restrict the processing of, object to and transfer your data.
- 9. You may file a complaint with a supervisory authority (President of the Office for the Protection of Personal Data or the Inspector General for the Protection of Personal Data) if you feel that the processing of your personal data violates the provisions of the Regulation of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data, and repealing Directive 95/46/EC.
- 10. You will not be subject to automated decision-making, including profiling.
